

IMPORTANT NOTICE OF SERVICE CHANGE

Effective immediately, Howie's **will no longer accept Plastics #3-7** in our Recycling Center or through our Curbside Recycling Service. This is due to a global downturn in the demand for these types of plastic products. Please discard all #3-#7 plastics with your regular household trash.



Examples of plastics #1-2

- #1 PETE (water and soda bottles, cooking oil containers, plastic peanut butter jars and containers)
- #2 HDPE plastic wrappings (milk jugs, shampoo bottles, detergent bottles)



Examples of plastics #3-7

- #3 PVC materials (plastic tubing, kids' toys, plastic trays)
- #4 LDPE plastic wrappings (grocery bags, bread bags)
- #5 Polypropylene (yogurt, sour cream, and margarine containers, straws)
- #6 Polystyrene (disposable coffee cups, packing peanuts, to-go food containers)
- #7 Other plastics that do not fit in the above categories (made from multiple types of plastics; these will be labeled on the bottom with a #7)

Howie's will continue to take all glass materials at the Recycling Center. As a reminder, glass is not accepted through our Curbside Recycling Service.
